Mr. Stephen Hung has been a member of Council of The Law Society of Hong Kong (“the Law Society”) since 2003. Mr. Hung holds the office of Immediate Past President at present. Mr. Hung was elected as President of the Law Society from August 2014 to May 2016. He is currently the Chairman of the Law Society’s Legal Education Committee.



As a representative of the Law Society, Mr. Hung serves on the PCLL Academic Board of the University of Hong Kong, Chinese University of Hong Kong, and City University of Hong Kong, Steering Committee on the Provision of Legal Advice for Litigants in Person, Judicial Officers Recommendation Commission, and Professional Services Advancement Support Scheme Vetting Committee Panel on Commerce and Industry.

In his own capacity, Mr. Hung serves on the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority, the Communications Authority, the Law Reform Commission, Sub-committee on Causing or Allowing the Death of a Child, and the Lump Sum Grant Steering Committee.

Mr. Hung is an Adjunct Professor of Law of Hong Kong Shue Yan University. He is also a Visiting Professor of the Faculty of International Law of China University of Political Science and Law in Beijing, China.
