# Introduction

Impacts of the EU Human Rights Due Diligence Directive are significant even in Asia, including Japan. The EU Directive would require EU Member States to transpose into national law a corporate due diligence duty to identify, prevent, mitigate and account for adverse human rights and environmental impacts. The duty would apply to a business company's own operations, its subsidiaries and their supply chains. In other words, the EU Directive will have strong impacts not only in Europe but in Asia, including Japan.

What is the purpose of the EU Directive and why is it needed?

Why must a non-EU company be compelled to obey the EU Directive? A possible answer is that the interests to be protected by the Directive are global ones, such as is the case of anti-money laundering, anti-corruption and environmental protections.

The panel of experts will address the Directive and its implications for application beyond Europe, including Asia, and will provide best practices for lawyers in the 21<sup>st</sup> century advising multinational business clients.

The seminar will be held on Thursday, March 21 and March 22 in Tokyo and will include a cocktail reception and Gala Dinner in the evening of March 21. An excursion to Kamakura, the old capital of Japan established by Samurai will be organised on Sunday, March 24.

### → CANCELLATION CONDITIONS

All cancellations will be subject to a 50% deduction and will have to be sent in writing, to be received by the Union Internationale des Avocats **no later than February 21, 2024.** 

No refund will be made for cancellations received after this date.

### VISAS

Anyone who requires a visa invitation letter in order to attend the seminar should register and pay their registration fees **no later than February 21**, **2024** to ensure there is enough time to obtain a visa.
