All cancellations will be subject to a 20% processing fee and must be sent in writing to the UIA (Union Internationale des Avocats) no later than 28 January 2026. No refund will be made for cancellations received after this date.

Participants who have paid the total registration fee and who are unable to attend the seminar personally may send a colleague as a substitute after informing the UIA. A €50 processing fee will be charged.

VISAS

Anyone who requires a visa invitation letter in order to attend the seminar should register and pay their registration fees **no later** than 28 January 2026 to ensure there is enough time to obtain a visa.
