14:30 – 15:45 CO-MEDIATION: Are two Heads Always Better than One? Positive Aspects and Pitfalls about the Co-Mediation Format

The co-mediation option may represent a sound instrument to tackle specific arrays of disputes (multi-party, cross-cultural, environmental, etc.) and may present both potential benefits and possible drawbacks to be adequately regarded. 



FORCE MAJEURE

All cancellations will be subject to a 50% deduction and will have to be sent in writing, to be received by the Union Internationale des Avocats no later than May 22, 2018. No refund will be made for cancellations received after this date.

Anyone who requires a visa invitation letter in order to attend the seminar should register and pay their registration fees no later than May 22, 2018 to ensure there is enough time to obtain a visa.

All cancellations will be refunded in full, minus €50 + VAT to cover administrative costs, provided that the UIA has received the registration documents and total registration fees no later than May 22, 2018.
