INTRODUCTION

This online UIA Capsule is the 1st of a series of 4 (Cycle 1) organized in 2024 by the (first) UIA Negotiation Laboratory, January 25, 2024 – Le (premier) Laboratoire de Négociation de l'UIA. The Med Lab CYCLE 1 looks at how structuring negotiation: tools for improving negotiation. This CYCLE 1 – Training N°1 will focuses on 2 useful negotiation techniques: CPS, a tool you can use to encourage creativity and facilitate the development of innovative solutions to difficult problems, & BATNA, a course of action that a party engaged in negotiations has determined should be taken if talks fail and no agreement can be reached.

What is CPS & BATNA and why are they important? How do you combine them in your negotiation? How to use them? Can this help you to boost your power at the bargaining table and how? Definitions, importance & Practical examples of CPS & BATNA/MeSoRe will be presented by 2 leading negotiation & mediation experts teaming to share their knowledge & experience.

The UIA Med Lab Capsules will be offered in English and/or French, depending on the particular speakers. The UIA Med Lab CYCLE 1 for 2024 will explore negotiation structure: tools for boosting bargaining power & improving negotiation. The UIA Med Lab CYCLE 2 for 2025 will explore self-knowledge and improvement: tools for acting more effectively as a mediator/neutral third party.
